However, due to scheduling conflicts with various school activities, such as the Parents' Night and the School Open Day preparation, the enhancement class sessions were often disrupted. Despite our active efforts to coordinate and reschedule, it was challenging to avoid these clashes, resulting in the successful completion of only 8 sessions. In terms of attendance, the initial sessions saw a relatively high attendance rate. However, as the term progressed and the examination period approached, student attendance declined.</p>	
F.5 Chemistry Enrichment Class	To enrich students' Chemistry knowledge	F.5 29 students	Feb 2025 - May 2025	<p>The same experienced retired chemistry teacher was employed to run the F.5 enhancement class. Drawing on the experience from the F.6 enhancement class, we made adjustments to the schedule to minimize conflicts with school activities. This allowed the F.5 enhancement class to successfully run for 14 sessions. Students reported that the teacher effectively addressed their weaknesses, which significantly boosted their confidence.
